As per letter read above, the Director of Fisheries has furnished proposal for additional authorization of Rs. 12 Crore to the H/A 2405-00-103-77-01(P) and Rs.8 Crore to the H/A 2405-00-103-77-02(P) and also requested to accord sanction to transfer the amount to the Single Nodal Account of Directorate of Fisheries, opened for the PFMS.

2. As per Government Order read 2nd and 3rd above, a total of Rs. 20 Crore has been sanctioned through additional authorisation to utilize the General, SCP and TSP components of the central assistance along with corresponding state share for the scheme Integrated Development and Management of Fisheries under PMMSY.
